Our exchange application process includes 2 phases:

1. NOMINATION of students by the home university

Send your students' nominations by e-mail to exchange@elisava.net including the following information:

- Student's name and surname
- Student's e-mail address
- Field of study: Graphic design, Product design, Space-Interior design, Interaction design, Engineering in Industrial design
- Exchange period: 1st trimester, 2nd trimester, 3rd trimester, 1st & 2nd trimesters, 2nd & 3rd trimesters, full year
- Spanish language knowledge: Elementary, Intermediate, Advanced, No knowledge

Nomination deadlines:

For 1st trimester / 1st & 2nd trimesters / Full year
For 2nd trimester / 3rd trimester / 2nd & 3rd trimesters

2. APPLICATION online by the student

Application periods:

ONLINE APPLICATION PROCESS

- 1. We receive the student's nomination
- 2. We send an e-mail to the nominated student with some information about our online exchange application tool
- 3. The student submits his/her application online. The following documents in PDF format will have to be uploaded in the application tool:
 - Application form
 - Colour passport sized photo (JPG format)
 - Letter of motivation
 - Copy of passport or ID card (citizens from the UE. Norway or Switzerland)
 - Spanish language proficiency (basic or intermediate level A2 European level) * Not compulsory
 - Portfolio (max 10 Mb)
- 4. The student prints his/her application and send us a copy of it by e-mail to exchange@elisava.net
- 5. Additional requirements: Students applying for Graphic design are required to send us a portfolio in print form, A4 format, as well. Portfolios must be sent by post before the application deadline to the following address:

REMARKS

At ELISAVA, we use a trimester system instead of the traditional semester system, with an amount of 20 ECTS credits each trimester, for a total amount of 60 ECTS per year.

According to this structure, during each trimester of 3rd and 4th year, in which exchange students integrate mainly, we offer:

- a) Several modules of elective subjects, for a total amount of 20 ECTS/module, focused on Design (graphic, product, interior and Interaction design specialities) as well as Engineering in Industrial Design.
- b) Individual subjects in 2nd 3rd and 4th year, depending on credits requirements of each partner university.

The specific offer of subjects and course catalogue for the academic year 2018-19 will be communicated to partner universities as soon as possible.

Courses and programmes not available for exchange students:

- Final Degree Project course (4th year).
- "Study Abroad" programme
- Master degrees
- Postgraduate degrees

Exchange students will send their provisional LA before starting their exchange period and will be allowed to make some changes to the courses once they are registered at ELISAVA, depending on availability of places.

After the publication of the final results, exchange students' Transcripts of records will be sent to their home University International Offices by e-mail.
